November introduction:

Happy Thanksgiving everyone! This is the time of the year to really give thanks for what we have, our friends, and family. We at the NRL22 are very thankful for an amazing staff, competitors, and match directors. Without everyone's support and dedication this sport would never be where it is today. This month we challenge everyone to do something selfless for someone else, a family member, a neighbor, or friend that will brighten up their day and make their life just a little easier that day.

Equipment Update:

"A plate and single bag combination, attached or not attached, is considered 1 piece of equipment. It must be used together throughout the stage and may not exceed 9"x11"x7" together. Any piece of equipment added to a plate/bag combination is considered a second piece of equipment and is not allowed"

Section 5 C. 1. is the only rule that may be changed during the course of the season. All rule questions should be directed at each club's Match Director. The 2020/2021 NRL22 rules can be found at [NRL22 Rules](#).

We would like to thank DST Precision for coming on onboard and creating a free product for everyone to use that allows the shooter to practice this COF inside their home with the use of their DFAT device. The DFAT allows you to use the rifle and optic to dryfire practice in a very small area. With this adapter most scopes focus in the 11-15 feet range. You can find this month's COF range card here. Let's introduce a first time COF designer and competitor, Eric Petzoldt from Pinetucky Gun Club out of Blythe, Georgia. Thank you Eric on a challenging and fun COF this month.

Range requirements: This month's COF will require the 2020/2021 NRL22 standard target package, 55-gallon barrel, sawhorse, and stopwatch that can time down to a tenth of a second.

Safety suggestions: Weed whacker plastic string works very well for Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI). Using ECI ensures a rifle is not loaded and especially useful for Ruger 10/22's. The stages' starting positions were deliberately set up for safety. Ensure RO's are very close to new shooters and kids, especially in the positional and barricade stages in case the 180 rule is broken or a transition is made without the action open or safety engaged.

Scoring submissions: Download the NRL22 Scores sheet from the downloads section on NRL22.org, fill out the results, and submit scores sheet to matches@nrl22.org, followed by payment for admin fee. Deadline for submissions is **December 2nd, 2020**. Keep in mind that only NRL22 members are eligible for prizes and while we have a 30-day grace period for membership, if the prizes are already distributed, it is the competitor's loss. The live Facebook show for prizes will happen on **December 9th, 2020**.

Fall Harvest Celebration

Time: 120 Sec

Round Count: 10


Ranges and Targets: • 50 yards: KYL Rack with 1", 3/4", 1/2" & 1/4"

Equipment: 1 piece of equipment in accordance with the NRL22 rules.

Points: 1"=6pts; 3/4"=8pts; 1/2"=10pts; 1/4"=12pts , 108 points possible

Start Position: Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open

Description: On start signal, the shooter will take a prone supported position and engage the KYL from large to small with 1 shot each, hit to advance. If the shooter misses, they will start over with the largest target. If the shooter reaches the 1/4" target, they will remain on that target until they miss, run out of rounds, or time expires



Giving Thanks To Our Family And A Quick Trigger Finger

Time: 120 Sec

Round Count: 10

- Ranges and Targets:**
- 65 yards: 2" & 2.5" on a double hanger
 - 85 yards: 3" on a single hanger

Equipment: 1 piece of equipment in accordance with the NRL22 rules.

Points: 10 points per impact, 100 points possible

Start Position: Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open


Description: Upon the start signal, the shooter will take a position on the top right side of the sawhorse and engage the 65-yard targets from small to large with two shots each (hit or miss) strong side

The shooter will then engage the 85-yard target with one shot (hit or miss) strong side.

The shooter will then take a position on the top left side of the sawhorse and engage the 65-yard targets from small to large with two shots each (hit or miss) support side

The shooter will then engage the 85-yard target with one shot (hit or miss) support side.

Note: Support side means support eye, shoulder, and hand.



Thanksgiving Proclamation

Time: 120 Sec

Round Count: 10

- Ranges and Targets:**
- 42 yards: 1" target on a double hanger
 - 42 yards: 1" target on a double hanger
(Targets will be at least 15' to 25' apart)

Equipment: 1 piece of equipment in accordance with the NRL22 rules.

Points: 10 pts per impact plus 0.1 bonus points per second remaining, i.e. if 8.7 sec remain the shooter will earn 0.87 points. **For the PractiScore NRL22 template enter the total time elapsed in seconds.**


Start Position: Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open

Description: Upon the start signal, The shooter will take a supported position on the 55-gal barrel and engage the left target with one shot (hit or miss).

The shooter will then engage the right target with one shot (hit or miss).

The shooter will continue this cycle of engaging the left then right target until out of rounds.

If the shooter completes the course of fire before the time limit, the shooter will let the RO know by yelling "Done" to stop time.



Cornucopia Of Fun

Time: 120 Sec

Round Count: 10

- Ranges and Targets:**
- 25 yard: 1.5" & 2.5" on a double hanger
 - 62 yards: 3" on a double hanger
 - 99 yards: 1.5" & 2.5" on a double hanger

Equipment: 1 piece of equipment in accordance with the NRL22 rules.

Points: 10 points per impact, 100 points possible

Start Position: Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open

Description: Upon the start signal, The shooter will take a supported prone position and engage the 1.5" targets from near to far (25 yds then 99 yds) with one shot each.

The shooter will engage the 2.5" targets from near to far (25 yds then 99 yds) with one shot each.


The shooter will engage the 3" target with one shot.

The shooter will engage the 1.5" targets from near to far (25 yds then 99 yds) with one shot each.

The shooter will engage the 2.5" targets from near to far (25 yds then 99 yds) with one shot each

The shooter will engage the 3" target with one shot.

NOTE: The shooter may not adjust magnification, windage, or elevation once given the start signal. Only parallax may be adjusted.



Standing Around For Seconds and Thirds

Time: 120 Sec

Round Count: 10

- Ranges and Targets:**
- 60 yards: 4" on a single hanger
 - 80 yards: 5" & 6" on single hangers

Equipment: Sling Only

Points: 10 points per impact, 100 points possible

Start Position: Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open

Description: Upon start signal,


Step 1. The shooter will take a standing position and engage the 4" target with one shot.

Step 2. The shooter will then engage the 5" target with one shot.

Step 3. The shooter will then engage the 6" target with one shot.

The shooter will then repeat step 1, 2, and 3 until all rounds fired or time expires.

Note: All shots are hit to advance.




FIG.1: Standing Unsupported Position
