



# JANUARY 2021 NRL22 OFFICIAL COURSE OF FIRE

January introduction:

Welcome to 2021! Hopefully we all can forget about the craziness of 2020 and move on to a better year. May this year bring you many joys professionally, personally, and competitively. We only have one more official COF after this month, that being said we will still publish a COF for March and April.

## **Equipment Update:**

“A plate and single bag combination, attached or not attached, is considered 1 piece of equipment. It must be used together throughout the stage and may not exceed 9"x11"x7" together. Any piece of equipment added to a plate/bag combination is considered a second piece of equipment and is not allowed”

Section 5 C. 1. is the only rule that may be changed during the course of the season. All rule questions should be directed at each club's Match Director. The 2020/2021 NRL22 rules can be found at [NRL22 Rules](#).

We would like to thank DST Precision for coming onboard and creating a free product for everyone to use that allows the shooter to practice this COF inside their home with the use of their DFAT device. The DFAT allows you to use the rifle and optic to dryfire practice in a very small area. With this adapter most scopes focus in the 11-15 feet range. You can find this month's COF range card here. Let's introduce our COF designers, Erik Severson and JD Darley from Sage Range Precision Rimfire out of Ridgecrest, California. Thank you guys for this awesome and challenging COF this month.

Range requirements: This month's COF will require the 2020/2021 NRL22 standard target package, tank trap, rooftop, sawhorse, and stopwatch that can time down to a tenth of a second.

Safety suggestions: Weed whacker plastic string works very well for Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI). Using ECI ensures a rifle is not loaded and especially useful for Ruger 10/22's. The stages' starting positions were deliberately set up for safety. Ensure RO's are very close to new shooters and kids, especially in case the 180 rule is broken or a transition is made without the action open or safety engaged.

Scoring submissions: Download the NRL22 Scores sheet from the downloads section on NRL22.org, fill out the results, and submit scores sheet to [matches@nrl22.org](mailto:matches@nrl22.org), followed by payment for admin fee. Deadline for submissions is **February 3rd, 2021**. Keep in mind that only NRL22 members are eligible for prizes and while we have a 30-day grace period for membership, if the prizes are already distributed, it is the competitor's loss. The live Facebook show for prizes will happen on **February 10th, 2021**.

# 2020. Rated 1 Star, Would Not Recommend

Time: 120 Sec

Round Count: 10

**Ranges and Targets:** 60 yds, 2" steel on a single hanger  
90 yds 2.5" steel on a single hanger  
100 yds 3" steel on a single hanger

**Equipment:** 1 piece of equipment in accordance with the NRL22 rules.

**Points:** 10 points per impact, 100 points possible

**Start Position:** Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open

**Description:** Upon start signal, shooter will take a position in the center of the trap and engage the 60 yd target with 2 shots.


Move to one of the tips and engage the 90 yd target with 2 shots.

Move to another tip and engage the 100 yd target with 2 shots.

Move to another tip and engage the 90 yd target with 2 shots.

Move back to the center and engage the 60 yd target with 2 shots.

All 3 tips must be used.



# Here's Hoping 2020 Really Is Hindsight!

Time: 120 Sec

Round Count: 12

**Ranges and Targets:** 25 yds, .25" on KYL rack  
40 yds, .5" on a KYL rack  
50 yds, 1" on a double hanger  
70 yds, 1.5" on a double hanger  
100 yds, 2" steel on a single hanger.

**Equipment:** 1 piece of equipment in accordance with the NRL22 rules.

**Points:** 10 pts per impact plus 0.1 bonus points per second remaining, i.e. if 8.7 sec remain the shooter will earn 0.87 points. **For the PractiScore NRL22 template enter the total time elapsed in seconds.**

**Start Position:** Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open


**Description:** On the start signal shooter will assume a supported prone position and engage the targets in the following order with 1 shot each, hit or miss move on:

25, 40, 25, 40, 50, 40, 50, 70, 40, 50, 70, 100.

If the shooter completes the COF before the time limit, the shooter will let the RO know by yelling "DONE" to stop the time.

Note: Extended magazines will NOT be allowed on this stage. A maximum round count per magazine is no more than 10 rounds

**Ranges and Targets:** 50 yards: 1" & 1.5" target on a double hanger


**Equipment:** 1 piece of equipment in accordance with the NRL22 rules.

**Points:** 10 points per impact, 100 points possible

# I'M FINE 2020

**Start Position:** Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open

**Description:** On the start signal, the shooter will engage each target with 1 shot from small to large from the following positions:

1. Prone supported on left side of sawhorse
2. Top of the sawhorse
3. Bottom shelf of the sawhorse
4. Top of the sawhorse
5. Prone supported on the right side of sawhorse

# 365 New Days. 365 New Chances

Time: 120 Sec

Round Count: 10

**Ranges and Targets:** 75 yard: 2" on a double hanger  
100 yards: 3" on a double hanger

**Equipment:** 1 piece of equipment in accordance with the NRL22 rules.


**Points:** 10 points per impact, 100 points possible

**Start Position:** Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open

**Description:** On the start signal, shooter will take a position on the left side of the rooftop, both feet must be on the ground and engage the 75, 100, 75 yd target with 1 shot each. Shooter will move onto the rooftop; entire body must be on the rooftop and engage the 75 and 100 yd targets with 2 shots each.

Shooter will take a position on the right side of the rooftop, both feet must be on the ground and engage the 75, 100, 75 yd target with 1 shot each. For this engagement shooter must shoot support side.

Note: Support side means support side eye, shoulder and hand. If shooter is left handed, their support side engagement will be from the left side of the rooftop.



# Building A New Foundation For 2021

**Time: 120 Sec**

**Round Count: 10**

**Ranges and Targets:** 100 yards: 1.5" & 2.5" on a double hanger

**Equipment:** 1 piece of equipment in accordance with the NRL22 rules.


**Points:** 10 points per impact, 100 points possible

**Start Position:** Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open

**Description:** On the start signal shooter will assume a supported prone position and engage the targets from small to large with 1 shot each.

Shooter will stand up with rifle and equipment in hand. Shooter will reassume a supported prone position and repeat the target engagement.

Shooter will repeat this process until all 10 rounds are shot or time expires.




FIG.1: Standing Unsupported Position
